

Frequently Asked Questions – First Aid

How old do I have to be to take a course?

Minimum age for most First Aid courses is 16-years-old.

For Emergency Medical Responder the minimum age is 18-years-old

For Babysitting the minimum age is 11-years-old.

How long is my certificate valid?

Red Cross certificates are valid for 3-years from the date of course completion.

The only exception is BLS 1-year.

If my certificate is expired can I take a recertification course?

No, Red Cross legislation states that a certificate must be current in order to be eligible to take a recertification course.

How do I receive my certification?
